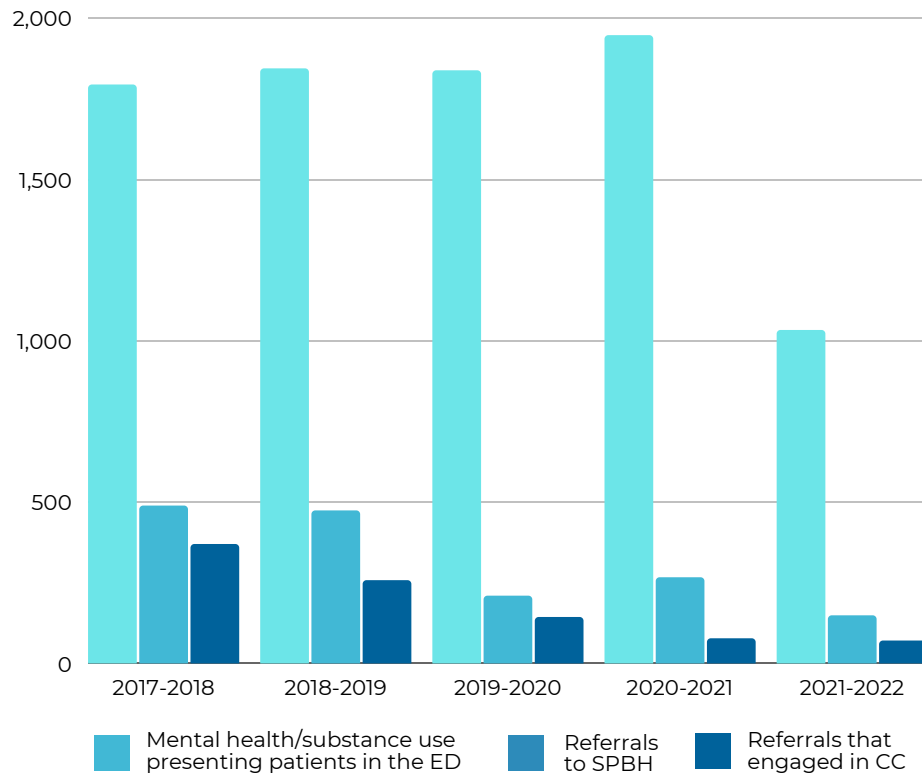


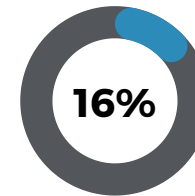
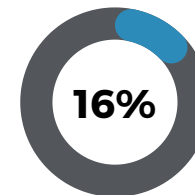
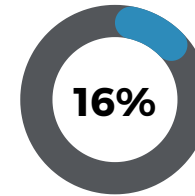
# CARE COORDINATION (CC) PARTNERSHIP

A partnership with Baptist Medical Center Nassau to reduce recidivism in the ED

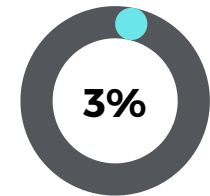
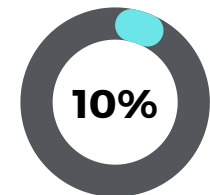
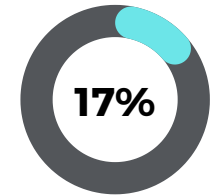

## A Partnership Success Story

A patient went into the Baptist Nassau ED after overdosing on heroin, cocaine, and cannabis. The patient was then referred to Starting Point's Care Coordination program and was determined to get her life "back on track". A Care Coordinator and Peer Specialist worked with the individual, providing her with tools and resources to maintain sobriety and regain control of her life. And it worked. Because of the support and direction provided by the Care Coordination team, this individual jumpstarted her recovery process, discovered new ways of coping, and waved goodbye to the Nassau County ED.
